

GeorgiaState University

Applied Religious Studies BA and MA

Our program is a humanities course of studies with professional emphasis. The BA is an interdisciplinary degree using professional skill emphasis to prepare students to work in nonprofit, grad school, journalism, education, law school and etc. The MA program is funded and provides professional certificates such as non-profit management, gerontology and other partnerships.

Beckman Scholars Program

The Beckman Scholars Program gives high-performing undergraduate students in the fields of biomedical sciences, biology, chemistry and neuroscience the opportunity to conduct independent laboratory research under the mentorship of select, expert faculty mentors. Beckman Scholars will benefit from additional professional development opportunities and will be well-positioned to pursue their graduate educations and careers in science. Beckman Scholars will receive \$21,000 over 15 months, including travel and supplies, and their faculty mentors will receive \$5,000 to support educational expenses for their scholars.

Center for the Advancement of Students and Alumni (CASA)

The CASA offers centralized programming to generate interest and promote activities in pursuit of advanced degrees. We do this in a variety of ways, including offering four summer internship programs, four academic year assistantships, travel awards, transition grants, individual professional mentoring, and more.

Cyber Security

Serve as a Work Study Student Assistant in the Cyber Security Operation Center participating in interactive experiences of real-world cyber security events. We offer experimental learning of Next Generation Cyber Security tools and mentoring from a exceptional staff.

Department of World Languages and Cultures

We offer virtual exchange with peer students in other countries; we offer study abroad programs; we arrange for internships and experiential learning opportunities (e.g., translation for the GA Public Defender's Office, Well Star, etc.).

Digital Learners to Leaders

Through Digital Learners to Leaders (DLL) internship course, student-led teams create digital solutions to real challenges students identify. You'll grow digital skills and develop your portfolio, with support and guidance from a diverse group of technology professionals in Atlanta's education, business, government, and non-profit communities. DLL provides a unique opportunity to demonstrate to future employers skillsets in digitization and problem-solving.

EPIC (Experiential, Project-based, Interdisciplinary Curriculum)

EPIC provides GSU students opportunities to develop foundational skills to help them become adaptable problem-solvers, overcoming the academic challenges they face in their studies and creating solutions to the issues they will tackle as they graduate into their professions and lives. The program combines the strengths of an enhanced interdisciplinary education (critical thinking, problem-solving, communication skills) with innovative research and project-based labs. Georgia State is piloting the EPIC program, with elements including integrated Freshman Learning Communities (FLCs) and Project Labs.

Georgia State Production Network

At Georgia State Production Network (GSPN), students gain valuable experience in the television and sports industries while broadcasting live Division I Athletics events for ESPN. Students in GSPN produce and broadcast live sports on the ESPN family of networks. Additionally, students create original video content for the university, including commencement ceremonies, inaugurations, GHSA state championships, the MEAC/SWAC Challenge, and other non-sporting events.

Georgia State University Police Department

GSU Biology Department

Students work and receive training in a setting where psychological methods and principles are applied in a community setting (PSYC4770) or through directed research in faculty labs (PSYC4760).

GSU Signature Experiences

Signature Experience courses optimize learning by doing through hands-on experiences. These courses are found in every major and include opportunities such as internships, research, service-learning, and more.

GSU/GT Center for Advanced Brain Imaging (Reading Research Lab)

Honors College Thesis and Discovery Undergraduate Journal

The Quality Assurance in Life Science Industries Certificate is an opportunity to gain unique training that equips students to join the biotech or pharmaceutical industry with a bachelor's degree. We also partner with a nonprofit that provides students with extra mentorship, internship and job opportunities, and a hiring platform as they complete the credential.

National Center for Sexual Violence Prevention

We offer volunteer research assistantships where students will work on research projects focused on sexual violence, substance use, and mental health.

Project Paths at the Resilient Families and Youth Lab

We are a study that is focused in learning about STEM students journey at GSU.We are recruiting more students for the study and looking for potential research assistants to join our psychology lab.

Research and Internships for Neuroscience Students

STEP PREP aims to reduce barriers in the psychology graduate education process by supporting BIPOC undergraduate students through mentorship. Currently, STEP PREP provides resources for applications to graduate school including an asynchronous lecture series.

University Career Services

University Library

The University Library provides many opportunities for student research and learning. Students can meet subject librarians who provide specialized instruction and consultation in their academic area, discover unique primary source archival material in Special Collections and Archives, and learn valuable new data skills with Research Data Services.
